

The descriptions that will be hung on the quilts are based on the information you provide on the Registration Form so it is necessary to be accurate.

Have you noticed how many quilt shows are being staged in the month of May, around the Lower Mainland and in Victoria? Hope you are planning to attend a few. It may provide the inspiration or impetus you need to complete your quilts for our show.

**Name Tags** – Remember to bring your name tag with you. If you forget it I will have sticky tags for a donation of 25 cents – remember, you can't win the door prize without a name tag. Look for people with a colour border on their name tag, this means they are either a guest or a new member. Please help them to feel welcome!!

### Quilt Registration for 2008 Show

1. Registration will be held during the April, May and June meetings. You must be a member of the guild, in good standing, by March 19/08 in order to be able to register quilts for the show. The first and second choice registration forms and Rules of Entry are being mailed to all members in early April. Please fill in ALL sections of the registration form. All forms must be legible so please type or print clearly and remember to keep your descriptions to 50 words or less. All the first choice quilts will be hung. If we do not have enough space to hang all the second choice quilts, they will be selected in the order that they were registered. If you need instructions for the quilt sleeve we will have them on the registration table at the meetings.
2. We ask registrants to provide a 4"x6" color photo of the quilt attached to your registration form. For those who are unable to provide a picture we will take pictures for you. The cost is \$1.00 per picture. Pictures must be provided, or taken, at the same time that you register your quilts.
3. Copyright: registrants must provide information on where their pattern comes from—ie: kit, magazine, book, workshop, teacher, original design. It is important to acknowledge everyone who has worked on your quilt. This information should be written under the Quilt Construction Information on the registration form.

Registrations may also be mailed to me or dropped off at my home. **NO** registrations will be accepted after **June 30/08**. Please call me if you have any questions.

### Meltdown & Burnout with Eileen Neill

In this workshop we will explore some non-traditional materials such as Tyvek, polyester sheers, plastic wrapping paper, metallic fabric paints, and puff paints to make interesting surfaces. These melted and distressed pieces can then be applied, to fabric to make small wall hangings. In working with these materials I have tried melting them using various heating appliances with unusual results.

The first day we will mainly experiment with the materials and techniques. On the second day we will use the interesting samples that we have made to make a small collaged wall hanging.
