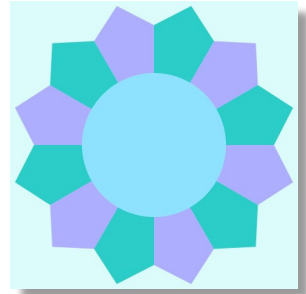

Just to remind everyone that on the afternoon of our June meeting, we will have some batting for Community Quilts available at the church from 2 to 4 pm.

It really helps if you email either Brenda S or Linda H (contact details in the covering email) with the size of your quilt top and whether you intend to quilt it on a standard machine or on a long-arm one (it makes a difference on how much extra we need to allow).



Also if you need backing, please include a picture of your quilt top so we can select something that matches.
